This petition had been filed seeking quashing of the order in a complaint case.

The petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender. It was claimed that he was abroad since the year 2000 and he could not have been declared proclaimed offender.

Since it was a matrimonial dispute, efforts were being made for over 3 years to see if the matter could be settled but mediation has failed.

The petitioner in pursuance to order dated 19.05.2017, had already appeared before the trial Court and was admitted to interim bail.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of and order dated 19.05.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute

The petitioner would deposit his passport with the trial Court. In case he has to travel for any urgent reason, he can file an application and will seek prior permission before going abroad.
