This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing/modification of order dated 01.02.2016 passed by the JMJC, Panchkula and order dated 18.10.2016 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Panchkula wherein the respondents have been awarded maintenance.

Notice of motion of the instant petition was issued subject to deposit of Rs. 50,000/- towards arrears of maintenance.

This matter has been taken up on three different occasions and as per Office report, the amount of Rs. 50,000/- has not been deposited so far. By the last order dated 26.10.2017, it had been ordered that in case the order dated 30.11.2016 is not complied with, interim order passed on the said date shall be vacated.

At this juncture, appearance has been put in on behalf of the petitioner who submits that the matter has been resolved between the parties and a decree of divorce has been obtained by them under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act.

In view of above, no further orders are called for and the petition is disposed of accordingly. However, while disposing of the instant petition, the petitioner is granted liberty to revive the same in case any grouse still survives.
