The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.111 dated 18.05.2018 registered under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC at Police Station Bajghera, District Gurugram.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the complainant has been examined in Court as a witness. While appearing as a witness before the Court, the complainant has categorically deposed that the petitioners have not snatched anything from him. It is further contended that the petitioners are in custody since 19.06.2018. Since the trial is going on, therefore, the petitioners are not required for any investigation purposes.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel, being instructed by ASI Haresh Kumar, submits that the mobile phone of the complainant was recovered from petitioner No.1. It is further pointed out that there is another case against petitioner No.3 under Section 323 IPC.

In view of the above submissions of counsel for the petitioners, but without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is

allowed. It is ordered that the petitioners be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
