The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 23 dated 05.07.2018 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran.

Learned State counsel submits that the FSL report has not been received yet and, thus, the investigation is still in progress.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that 1540 loose tablets were recovered from the petitioner and they were not marked and, thus, as on date it can not be said that the petitioner has violated any provisions of the Act, 1985. There is no other case under the said Act pending against the petitioner and, thus, the petitioner is entitled to interim bail.

The petition is disposed of with direction that the petitioner be released on bail till the receipt of report of the FSL, on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned. He shall surrender before the trial Court on the date report of the FSL is received.
