TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (Oral)

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.234 dated 30.04.2016, registered under Section 135 of Electricity Act, 2003, registered at Police Station Anti Power Theft, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 08.11.2017:-

It is inter alia contended that the petitioner Rajinder Singh had been regularly appearing before the Court below

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and it is only a single date default on 14.09.2017 he could not put in appearance for the reasons beyond his control.

Notice of motion for 16.03.2018.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall put in appearance before the trial Court within 15 days from today and on his doing so he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court. However, it is made clear that this order shall become inoperative if the petitioner is found to have absented for more than one occasion.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, Police Station Anti Power Theft, District Jalandhar apprises the Court that the petitioner has since put in appearance before the trial Court and has been admitted to interim bail upon having furnished requisite bail bonds/surety bonds.

In view of the categoric stand taken on behalf of the State, prayer is allowed.

Order dated 08.11.2017, passed by this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of.
