Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.510 dated 04.07.2018 under Sections 3/4/5/7/8 of the Immoral Trafficking Act, 1956, Section 120 IPC, Section 14(i)(b) of the Foreigners Act, 1946 and Section 3 of the Passports Act, 1967 registered at Police Station DLF Sector 29, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon order dated 07.09.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-35737-2018 *Rrakhong Mungaomk Lang and another Vs. State of Haryana* and order dated 18.09.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M-39850-2018 *Pitchayapak*

Dumdangdee and another Vs. State of Haryana, whereby the co-accused of the petitioner have been admitted on bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sandeep Kumar, does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that similarly placed co-accused have already been admitted on bail by this Court, the petitioner who is in custody since 04.07.2018 is also entitled to be considered at par with them. Therefore, I deem it appropriate to release her on regular bail. However, since the petitioner is a foreign national, some severe conditions are required to be imposed while releasing her on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of her bail bonds/heavy surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court with an undertaking that she will not leave the country and her passport would not be released without prior permission of the Court.
