This is the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing respondents no.1 to 5 to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioner from respondents no. 6 to 9. In this regard the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 26.09.2018 (Annexure P-1), however, till date no action has been taken by respondent No.3 on the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if respondent No.3 be directed to look into the representation dated 26.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) and take action in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Rajni Gupta, learned Sr. DAG, Punjab who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Three copies of the petition be handed over to her by learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day failing which no action is called for.

Heard.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent no.3 to decide the representation dated 26.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) and grant her protection, if any threat to her life and liberty is perceived.
