Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 513 dated 23.06.2017 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 341, 506 and 306 (added later on) of IPC, registered at Police Station Saran, District Faridabad.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in judicial lock-up since 24.06.2017 and statement of complainant has already been recorded and only the official witnesses are remained to be recorded and there is no possibility to influence the prosecution witnesses.

Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is ready to deposit an amount of Rs.20,000/- with the trial Court to be paid to the complainant on account of medical expenses. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other case except this case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from H.C. Sumit Kumar, has opposed the prayer of bail on the ground that the complainant and one doctor have supported the prosecution version.

Without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in judicial lock-up since 24.06.2017 and the conclusion of the trial will take sometime and the petitioner is ready to deposit an amount of Rs.20,000/- with the trial Court, the petitioner is directed to release on bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate. This will be, however, subject to deposit of Rs.20,000/- with the trial Court and the trial Court will remit the amount in favour of injured-Manoj.
