The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.74 dated 22.08.2017, under Sections 406, 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the

investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 08.11.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
