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GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 290 dated 28.09.2005 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station Division No. 4, Jalandhar along with all the subsequent and consequential proceedings arising out of the FIR on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 11.05.2018 this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for getting their statements recorded with regard to compromise, so as to ascertain genuineness of the compromise.

Report of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar has been received, wherein it has been stated that pursuant to the order dated 11.05.2018, statements of complainant – Dinesh Jain and of accused Kiranjit Kaur have been recorded. The learned trial Court in its report has opined that the compromise arrived at between the parties appears to be genuine and had been effected voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion and with free will of the parties.

In view of the aforesaid position, this Court is satisfied that the matter has been resolved amicably. As such, the petition is hereby accepted and the FIR and all subsequent proceedings are ordered to be quashed.
