The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure seeking permission to go to Australia for a period of three months from 15.10.2018 to 15.01.2019 to visit his son and grand children who are residing there in case FIR No.139 dated 26.11.2014, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC') at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga.

Proceedings qua petitioner has already been stayed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is allowed to go Australia for a period of three months from the date of furnishing bank guarantee in the sum of Rs.5,00,000/- and one surety of the equal amount to the satisfaction of the trial court/Duty Magistrate concerned with further conditions, if any, imposed by the learned trial court/Duty Magistrate.
