The instant petition has been preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0101 dated 13.05.2016, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station East Sector 26, Chandigarh.

Complainant in the present case was the Manager of the then State Bank of Patiala, Sector 07, Chandigarh.

Allegations in a nutshell are with regard to petitioner having availed of a total loan liability of amounting to Rs.19 lacs (two loan transactions) and the same having been obtained fraudulently.

The instant petition had come up for preliminary hearing on 18.03.2017 before this Court and at that point of time the submission made by counsel representing the petitioner was recorded to the effect that petitioner would be ready and willing to pay the installments for both the loan accounts regularly.

Against the backdrop of such undertaking petitioner was granted interim protection subject to his joining investigation.

Order sheets reveal that matter had been adjourned on various occasions thereafter on request made by counsel representing the petitioner so as to comply with the undertaking recorded before this Court on 18.03.2017.

Counsel representing the petitioner concedes before this Court during the course of hearing today that the undertaking recorded way back on 18.03.2017 has been deviated from and the installments have not been paid.

Conduct of the petitioner disentitles him from the concession of pre arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.

Needless to observe that the interim protection granted vide order dated 18.03.2017 would cease to operate.
