**INDERJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)**

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.90 dated 27.06.2018, registered at Police Station Rajaund, District Kaithal, under Sections 148, 149 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code, Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 323 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (added subsequently).

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel.

They contested this petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, the present petitioner fired a shot from the weapon, but it did not hit anybody. The main accused is Chhattar Pal, who fired a shot and caused injury to Prem Singh, maternal uncle of the complainant.

The petitioner has been in custody since 02.07.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
