Petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.904 dated 23.11.2016, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Sector-55, District Faridabad along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

The first petition for regular bail of the petitioner was dismissed on merits by the coordinate bench of this court vide judgment dated 19th April, 2018 passed in *CRM-M-8199-2018*.

Briefly stated, it is a case of prosecution that FIR has been registered against the petitioner on the allegations that one article called as 'RP' (rice puller) is a precious item and its market value worth Rs.30 crore and he duped Rs.1.35 crore from the complainant by forging certain documents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the material witnesses have been examined, photocopy of the evidence are placed on record. He further submitted that there is no cogent evidence in this regard.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submitted that the petitioner has executed an agreement on behalf of M/s. JJ Group company with regard to supply of the said article called 'RP'.

Serious allegations have been levelled against the petitioner. This is no stage to critically and meticulously examine the evidence available on record.

No new ground is made out after dismissal of the first petition for bail.

As such, the present petition is also dismissed.
