The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner No.2 in the event of arrest in FIR No.64 dated 06.04.2017, under Sections 376, 342, 506, 354-D, 323 34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 3/4 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for petitioner No.2 contends that the petitioner No.2 is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Sukhminder Singh, submits that petitioner No.2

has joined the investigation. In fact, a cancellation report has been prepared in this regard.

In view of the facts that petitioner No.2 has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 09.11.2017 granting interim bail to petitioner No.2 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
