ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. :

By invoking Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has prayed for quashing of FIR No.18 dated 26.01.2014 for offence punishable under Sections 307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered with Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar City.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 27.09.2018 of Assistant Commissioner of Police, South, Amritsar City, filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. It is mentioned in para No.10 of the affidavit that the cancellation report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been prepared on 27.08.2017.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Devinder Singh, submits that the cancellation report has been submitted before the Illaqa Magistrate and is pending adjudication.

In view of the same, this petition is rendered infructuous, at this stage. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition, if so required.
