Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has produced an order passed by the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Chandigarh, dated 14.02.2017, whereby, after conviction, respondent No.2-Ranjan Sood stands convicted under Section 323 of the Indian Penal Code and thereafter, has been released on probation with further sentence to pay litigation cost of ₹ 500/- and compensation of ₹ 3,000/- to the complainant. He further states that no appeal has been preferred by the complainant against the said order, which has attained finality.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for respondent No.2, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous as in the present petition, challenge was to the order dated 12.07.2016 (Annexure P-2), whereby, charge under Section 323 of the Indian Penal Code was framed against respondent No.2, which order was upheld by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh, vide order dated 18.01.2017 (Annexure P-3).
