Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 14.

Reply by way of affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 filed in the Court is taken on record and as per the reply, the police has recorded the statement of petitioner No.1 – Lovepreet Kaur, who has stated that previously she was married with one Sukhdev Singh – respondent No.4 and 02 children were born out of this wedlock and thereafter, due to the maltreatment given by her husband, she has filed a case at Faridkot and now, she has solemnized marriage with Gurjeet Singh – petitioner No.2.

Similar statement is made by Gurjeet Singh that he has performed marriage with Lovepreet Kaur – petitioner No.1.

The police has also recorded the statement of Jaspal Singh – father-in-law of petitioner No.1, who has stated that she was married

with Sukhdev Singh in the year 2010 and now he has no concern with petitioner No.1 – Lovepreet Kaur.

In the statement of respondent No.4 – Sukhdev Singh, it is stated that he has performed marriage with Lovepreet Kaur and 02 children were born out of this wedlock and now she has started living with petitioner No.2.

Similar is the statement of Bakhtaur Singh, father of petitioner No.1, who has stated that on coming to know that she has performed marriage with Gurjeet Singh, he has disowned her and has no connection with her. It is, thus, submitted in the affidavit that the petitioners are not in need of any police protection.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
