Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.0071, dated 12.05.2017, under Sections 406/420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sirsa Sadar, District Sirsa.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Briefly noticed, allegations levelled against the petitioner are that he has duped the complainant of a sum of Rs.3 lakhs on the pretext of being sent abroad.

Petitioner was arrested on 25.05.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and challan stands presented. Even charges have been framed.

Trial would take time to conclude.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jagmeet Singh concedes to the fact that the petitioner is not involved in any other FIR of similar nature.

In the considered view of this Court, no useful purpose would

be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the completion of the trial.

Without making any observations on merit, petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial
