The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to respondent No.2 to investigate and decide the complaint/representation dated 20.09.2018 and to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 and 5 expeditiously.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against respondent No.3, 4 and 5 herein who are the main persons involved. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation/complaint should be decided expeditiously and appropriate legal action be taken against respondents No.3, 4 and 5.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Rajni Gupta, Sr. DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide

the representation/complaint of the petitioner within a period of two months, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation/complaint dated 20.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
