Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.65, dated 25.08.2017, under Sections 147/149/436/511 IPC, registered at Police Station GRPS Kurukshetra, District Kurukshetra.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered against 50/60 unidentified persons who are alleged to have gone on a rampage at railway station Kalayat in protest against the conviction of Gurmeet Ram Rahim Singh.

Present petitioner was arrested on 09.10.2017.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Rajinder Singh apprises the Court that investigation in the case is complete and challan has been presented.

As per State counsel, the collective damage inflicted by 50-60 unnamed assailants has been assessed to be Rs.11276/-.

Trial is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

In the considered view of this Court, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the conclusion of the trial.

Co-accused, Baljeet Singh has been granted benefit of bail by this Court in the light of order dated 05.02.2018 passed in CRM-M-3984-2018.

Without making any observations on merit, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Trial Court /Duty Magistrate concerned.
