JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant Ist and 2nd ACP after completion of 10/20 years of service as per the Assured Career Progression Scheme, 1998.

2. In response to notice of motion issued by this Court, respondents filed their written statements. But during the pendency of instant petition, matter has been resolved by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Civil Appeal No.4446 of 2008 captioned as ***State of Haryana & anr. vs.***

Deepak Sood & ors. Decided on July 15, 2008. Learned counsel for the petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide his legal notice dated 13.08.2007 (P-6) in light of the aforesaid judgment in a time bound manner.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 13.08.2007 (P-6) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order as per rules, regulations and instructions as well as in the light of Civil Appeal No.4446 of 2008 captioned as **State of Haryana & anr. vs. Deepak Sood & ors.** decided on July 15, 2008, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, he shall be at liberty to have recourse to the other remedies available under law as well as to approach this Court.
