The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.6201 dated 4.10.2017 under section 135 of Indian Electricity Act, registered at Police Station, Irrigation & Power Department, Ambala, district Ambala.

FIR was registered on the complaint of S.D.O of the U.H.B.V.N.L with the allegations of committing theft of electricity from a certain factory/premises.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar makes a statement that the petitioner has already availed of the remedy of having the offence compounded and has made the deposit of the requisite fee/charges.

State counsel further submits that in view of such factual premise even a cancellation report is being prepared. State counsel states that under such circumstances, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of such categoric stand taken on behalf of the State, instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
