The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.84 dated 09.04.2013 registered under Section, 302, 307 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Kotwali, Faridkot, District Faridkot.

The bail is sought mainly on the ground that the trial has not been completed. However, keeping in view the role attributed to the petitioner that he entered in the hospital and fired shots on the deceased who was admitted in the hospital, no case to grant regular bail to him is made out.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed. However, the learned trial court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournment or even adjourning the case on day to day basis and conclude it within a period of 06 months.
