The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.148 dated 15.12.2017, registered under Sections 326, 323, 452, 506, 379, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he trespassed into the property of the complainant and caused hurt to him.

Learned State counsel has stated that now compromise has been effected. He further stated that petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 01.10.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
