The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.117 dated 11.09.2018, registered under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Division No.2, District Pathankot.

It is the allegation against the petitioner that when motorcycle No.PB-35-R-4477 was waylaid, he escaped and from the search of motorcycle, 22 bottles of liquor mark NAINA Premium Whiskey for sale in Union Territory, Chandigarh were recovered.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 01.10.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
