The present petition has been filed for quashing of the FIR No. 51 dated 06.04.2016 registered under Sections 452, 323, 506, 427 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, on the basis of compromise dated 28.10.2017 (Annexure P-2).
