Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing DDR No.30 dated 10.02.2017 (Annexure P-2) registered under Sections 323/354/506/34 IPC, at Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar, in main case FIR No.19 dated 10.02.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323/324/506/341/34 IPC at Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 29.07.2017 (Annexure P-3).

Pursuant to order dated 15.12.2017 of this Court, the parties

statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Jalandhar, has submitted her report vide letter bearing No.49, dated 30.01.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, vide Endst. No.277/G/JRK, dated 01.02.2018.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Jalandhar, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with their free will.

Considering the report of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Jalandhar, dated 30.01.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, aforesaid DDR No.30 dated 10.02.2017 (Annexure P-2) in aforesaid FIR No.19 dated 10.02.2017 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, is quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.

Disposed of accordingly.
