On 24.01.2018, it was observed that notice could not be issued to respondent No.2 due to non-filing of process fee and thereafter, 10 days' time was granted to the petitioner for filing of process fee and it was made clear that no further opportunity would be granted to the petitioner, if process fee is not filed, within the stipulated period.
