Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.88 dated 07.04.2018 under Sections 148, 149, 341, 323, 379-B, 325 IPC, registered at Police Station Adampur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the case there is no allegation about the fire arm injury to anybody. Co-accused Ajmal was having the pistol, whereas the other accused were armed with lathies and iron pipes. The injuries attracted the offence under Sections 323, 325 IPC and other offences are under Sections 148, 149, 341, 379-B and Section 25 of the Arms Act. He further states that the petitioner is in custody since 04.06.2018 and challan in this case has already been presented and charges have been framed.

Chander states that other cases are registered against the petitioner and regular bail of co-accused Gulab, who was involved in the case with the petitioner has already been dismissed as withdrawn by this Court on 14.08.2018 vide CRM-M-33973-2018 (Gulab Versus State of Haryana).

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

No doubt the petitioner is involved in other cases, but he is on bail in those cases, except FIR No.147 dated 04.06.2018 for which he has not applied for bail. Regular bail of co-accused Gulab has been dismissed as withdrawn by this Court. But in the case of co-accused Gulab, there is another case against him under Section 379-B IPC. The petitioner is in custody since 04.06.2018, challan in this case has been presented and charges have been framed, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
