This court is of the view that it is a fundamental principle of fair trial that the trial must be speedy.

Learned State counsel to submit the report and the witnesses he wants to examine and will submit the copy to the Senior Superintendent of Police, who will take all the arrangement for production of the witnesses before the learned trial court.

In this view of the matter, learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial within six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga is directed to produce all the witnesses before the learned trial court on the date fixed and if he failed to do so then he shall personally appear before that court and submit the explanation on the date fixed by the trial court.
