Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondent No.1 to change the investigation of case FIR No.177 dated 04.08.2018 under Sections 382 and 506 IPC and Section 30 Arms Act registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda.

On 01.10.2018, following order was passed by this Court:-

“It is inter alia contended that the husband of the petitioner has been falsely implicated and the police is manipulating the investigation. It has not taken into custody, the relevant CCTV footage and other evidence which would show that the case foisted upon the husband of the petitioner, is false.

Notice of motion.

Mr. K.S. Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 19.12.2018.

Respondent no.2 is directed to enquire into the matter personally and submit its report by way of his own affidavit on or before the next date of hearing.”

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Nanak Singh, IPS, S.S.P., Bathinda, which is taken on record.

On the basis of the status report so filed, learned State counsel has submitted that the investigation in the case is already complete and challan has been presented in Court.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, when challan is submitted and charge has been framed upon the petitioner, the prayer of the petitioner for change of Investigating Officer is no more survives.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of, the same having been rendered infructuous.
