Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.198 dated 26.04.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 427, 506 & 34 Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kotwali, District Faridabad.

This Court had passed an order on 20.11.2017 that this Court would not grant regular bail unless the complainant was examined before the trial Court. Now, it is not in dispute that the complainant PW-3-Rakesh Bhatia has been examined and perusal of

his deposition at Annexure P-7 shows that he has completely turned hostile and has not supported the prosecution case despite the fact that the injuries were allegedly caused by the petitioner and he had 32 stitches on his head.

In that view of the matter, petitioner be released on regular bail, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The **CRM-M-42518 of 2017** is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner to surrender his passport with the trial Court, if he possesses the same.
- (iv) The petitioner would file an undertaking to the trial Court that he will not commit the same or any other kind of offence in future.
- (v) Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
- (v) In case, the petitioner violates the above said conditions, this order of bail comes to an end automatically without reference to this Court.
