Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.24 dated 08.05.2018 under Sections 307, 325, 323, 341, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Pojewal, District SBS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that incident in this case had taken place on 06.05.2018, whereas FIR was registered on 08.05.2018. Petitioner is in custody since 09.05.2018 and no prosecution witness has yet been examined, therefore, trial in this case will take a long time.

Learned State Counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner in court today, which is taken on record. He does not dispute the custody period.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The injury caused on the person of Jasvir Singh is on the forehead and jaw of the injured. The accused is stated to have given a brick-blow on the person of Jasvir Singh, who is stated to be in the Police Department. Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 09.05.2018 and trial in this case may take a long time, no useful purpose will be served to keep the petitioner in custody, I deem it appropriate to admit him on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
