Pursuant to the order of this Court dated 16.02.2018, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dera Bassi (Sh. Purshottam S. Bal), submits that all the petitioners have joined the investigation and presently their custodial interrogation is not required.

He further submits that as regards the old record pertaining to the years in question, the petitioners claim to have handed it over to the complainant, Baldev Singh, who could not be joined in the investigation as he has been declared to be a Proclaimed Offender in an FIR registered against him.

In the aforesaid circumstances, the orders of this Court dated 19.01.2018 and 16.02.2018, are made absolute, subject to the petitioners continuing to join investigation as and when called for.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
