The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to respondent No.2 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondent No.4 and further for direction to respondent No.3 to not to harass and humiliate the petitioner and her family members at the instance of respondent No.4.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against respondent No. 4 herein who is the main person involved. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation (Annexure P/1) should be decided expeditiously and appropriate legal action be taken against respondents No.4.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Rajni Gupta, Sr.

DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of 8 weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 17.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of 8 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
