The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 107 dated 18.10.2017, under Sections 325, 323, 427, 452, 148 and 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District S.B.S. Nagar.

The operative part of the order dated 01.12.2017, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR and no injury has been attributed to them. He further contends that five accused have been specifically named in the FIR and injuries have also been attributed to them.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 01.12.2017, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jarnail

Singh, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation. He further submitted that challan stands presented and Section 452 IPC has been deleted. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the complainant

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 01.12.2017, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
