The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.137 dated 20.02.2017 under Sections 420, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Ballabgarh City, District Faridabad and all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise.

Report has been received from learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Faridabad to the effect that both the parties have recorded their statement and entered into compromise. It is stated that the compromise arrived between the parties is without any threat, pressure, undue influence or fraud.

The perusal of the FIR shows that it was a property dispute in which money was taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that now the the amount of Rs.5 lac have been returned and residential house has been transferred in favour of the respondent.

In view of the effect that the parties have amicably settled the dispute, FIR No.137 dated 20.02.2017 under Sections 420, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Ballabgarh City, District Faridabad along with all consequential proceedings, stands quashed qua the petitioner.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
