1. In the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to arrest respondent No. 4 who is an accused in FIR No. 25 dated 02.04.2017 under Sections 304/201/34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sekhwan, District Batala.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose of the instant petition would be achieved, at this stage, if a direction is issued to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) which is pending before respondent No. 2 and also to take appropriate legal action on it expeditiously.

3. In view of the above, respondent No. 2- Senior Superintendent of Police, District Batalaa, is directed to look into the matter and to decide the representation (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order and after affording an opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
