Petitioners-Suresh, Anil and Sunny have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.124 dated 16.05.2018, registered at Police Station Hansi Sadar, District Hansi, under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 34 IPC (later challaned under Sections 323, 34, 341, 506, 325 and 307 IPC).

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioners are not the main accused. Petitioners-Anil and Sunny are stated to be armed

with *lathis/dandas*. Simple injury with fist as well as leg blows has been attributed to petitioner-Suresh. Simple injury with *lathi/danda* on the head of Jitender has been attributed to petitioner-Anil. Petitioner-Sunny is stated to have caused simple injury on the head of Sagar.

The petitioners have been in custody since 06.06.2018. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
