FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners Darshan Kaur and Sarwan Singh in case registered by way of FIR No.91 dated 31.08.2018 at Police Station Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran under Section 498-A IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 04.10.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sabinder Singh who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no

objection if the interim order is made absolute submitting further that the parties have also effected compromise between themselves.

In the light of this stand of the State and in view of the orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 04.10.2018 is made absolute however, they shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. Thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
