The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 132 dated 07.08.2018, registered under Sections 457 and 380 of the IPC at Police Station City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The operative part of the order dated 08.10.2018, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a delay of seven days in registration of the same as the incident pertains to 31.07.2018 whereas the FIR in question was registered on 07.08.2018. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in fact it is a dispute between the complainant and his son Paramjit Singh regarding property and the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and she is not involved in any other case of theft. Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jasvir Singh, submits that the petitioner be directed to join investigation. List again on 18.12.2018.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 08.10.2018, has already appeared before the

SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 08.10.2018, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
