After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to raise all the points raised herein before the learned trial Court at the appropriate stage including the point that the complainant not being a money lender could not have advanced the loan in question and also that the signatures of the accused on the cheque in question are apparently forged being spelt differently and had not been affixed by the petitioner-accused.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. Needless to mention that if any such application is moved at the appropriate stage before the trial Court, the trial Court shall dispose of the same by passing a speaking order.
