[1]. Prayer made in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.140 dated 03.05.2014 registered under Sections 302/120-B/34 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Kanina District Mohendergarh.

[2]. Earlier petition i.e. CRM-M No.43345 of 2016 filed by the petitioner was dismissed on merits on 22.02.2017. Thereafter another petition i.e. CRM-M No.22223 of 2017 was also dismissed on 31.07.2017.

[3]. As per prosecution case, the allegations against the petitioner are that he along with co-accused picked up an

earthen pitcher and hit on the head of Des Raj @ Ravan. The accused thereafter inflicted injuries with rod and sticks on the head of Des Raj @ Ravan, who died on account of the injuries.

[4]. Co-accused Pawan and Manjeet have already been convicted and sentenced to life imprisonment. Other co-accused namely Rajesh, Ashok and Sonbir have also been convicted and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for 4 years along with fine of Rs.5000/-.

[5]. CRR No.1430 of 2016 titled '*Kuldeep vs. State of Haryana*' is pending consideration in the High Court against the order dated 30.01.2016 passed in the application under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

[6]. Petitioner was declared as a proclaimed offender and his presence was only secured by way of arrest thereafter by the police.

[7]. In view of antecedent behaviour of the petitioner and in view of dismissal of earlier petitions, I do not find any ground to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

[8]. This petition stands dismissed.
