The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to the official respondents to arrest the private respondents in FIR No.55 dated 21.07.2018, under Sections 376, 354-A, 450, 506 of Indian Penal Code and Section 67 of Information and Technology Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that the representation dated 18.09.2018 (Annexure P-2) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, AAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will

decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of six weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 18.09.2018 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
