For the reasons stated therein, prayer is allowed.

The objection raised by counsel for the petitioner and that had been taken note of in the order dated 27.03.2018 as regards 03 prosecution witnesses having not been examined would stand overruled.

Application disposed of.

Main Case

In pursuance to the order dated 27.03.2018 passed by this Court, State counsel has filed an affidavit dated 03.04.2018 of the Assistant Sub Inspector of Police (No.286) Ferozepur posted at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga and the same is taken on record.

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in

case FIR No.73 dated 18.04.2017, under Sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is of 90 kgs of poppy husk.

In the light of alleged recovery which would be construed as heavy as also commercial in nature, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner the benefit of bail.

Petition dismissed.
