Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Let four copies of the complete paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to issue notices to respondents No.4 to 7.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation dated 27.09.2018 (Anneuxre P-2) and take appropriate action thereupon within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In any case, it shall be ensured that no harm shall be caused either to the petitioner or to her partner.
