Heard.

In this case, the petitioner was named in the suicide note recovered from the purse of the deceased Pawan Kumar in which he has blamed the present petitioner Sandeep Kumar as one of the person responsible for his death. It was mentioned that regarding loan of Rs.ten lakhs taken from the petitioner one year ten months back, he has made it Rs.twenty lakhs and though the deceased has returned Rs.seven lakhs but he was demanding Rs.twenty lakhs and threatening the deceased. Petitioner was arrested on 26.10.2017. He is in custody since then.

Learned Standing counsel for UT Chandigarh has informed this Court that challan has been presented and out of 26 witnesses, 14 witnesses have been examined. It is also stated that co-accused has since been released

on bail.

Considering the period of detention and the fact that 14 witnesses have been examined, I am of the view that there is no need for further detention of the petitioner. As such, the application is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.
