RAMENDRA JAIN, J.

Through this petition, filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Ravi in a case arising from FIR No. 202 dated 24.11.2017, registered under Sections 302, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 201 IPC and Section 3(2-V) of SC & ST Act added later on), at Police Station Division No.5, District Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that 5 co-ccused of the petitioner namely; Happy and Jaspal Singh @ Shera, Ajay Pal Singh @ Nihang, Arshdeep Singh @ Gelu and Swaroop Singh @ Roop have been granted regular bail vide order dated 8.8.2018 passed by this Court in CRM-M No. 24081 of 2018, 10.9.2018 passed in CRM-M No. 37046 of 2018, 21.9.2018 passed in CRM-M No. 40465 of 2018 and CRM-M No. 40460 of 2018 respectively. Learned counsel contends that treating the case of the petitioner on same parity of the co-accused, he be enlarged on bail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel vehemently opposed the

application for grant of bail to the petitioner.

Having given thoughtful considerations to the submissions made by both the sides, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
