Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.148 dated 17.12.2016 under Sections 307, 341, 323, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 and Section 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the occurrence in this case has taken place on 16.12.2016 and FIR was registered on 17.12.2016. Thereafter, the matter was compromised between the parties on 31.01.2017. However, the petitioner is in custody since 28.08.2018 and since the matter has been compromised, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bar.

Ms. Navneet Kaur, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf

of the complainant and fairly admits that the matter has been compromised

between the parties on 31.01.2017.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Gursewak Singh does not dispute the custody period of the petitioner. However, he states that taking into consideration the nature of injuries, petitioner does not deserve to be admitted on bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 28.08.2018, trial in this case is likely to take a long time, furthermore, the matter has been compromised between the parties immediately after the occurrence i.e. on 31.01.2017, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
